WARREN EAST GARDEN CLUB BY-LAWS

Article I – Name

The name of this club shall be Warren East Garden Club.

Article II – Objects

The object of this club shall be to stimulate knowledge and love of gardening, to aid in the protection of native plants, birds, and the general environment; and to encourage general community beautification.

Article III – Membership

The membership of this club shall be (limited to 29) Active or Associate. Active Member: Any person eighteen years of age or over, interested in the objects for which this club is organized, who will attend the meetings of the club and be willing to serve in places of responsibility, if asked. Active Members may participate in programs, serve on committees, pay dues, and be entitled to vote and hold office.

Associate Member: Associate Members may not hold office or vote at club meetings.

Honorary Member: Individuals designated by vote of the club; no dues required.

Article IV – Duties of Officers

Section 1. It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings, and to perform all the duties appertaining to the office.

Section 2. The Vice President shall serve as program chairman.

Section 3. The Secretary shall keep the minutes of the meetings of the club and shall be custodian of all records pertaining to the office.

Section 4. The Treasurer shall receive all moneys of the club and deposit it in such bank as designated by the club. She shall collect all dues and keep an accurate account of all receipts and disbursements. A report shall be presented at each club meeting. All bills shall be paid by check on the Warren East Garden Club.

Article V – Dues

Annual dues shall be: Active Member \$20.00; Associate Member \$25.00. Honorary Members no dues. Dues are payable at the March meeting. Dues shall be used for the operation expenses of the club and for any approved project of the club.

Article VI – Regular Meetings

The regular meetings of this club shall be held on the fourth Tuesday of each month, March through December.

Article VII – Amendments

These By-Laws may be amended at any regular meeting by a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting, provided proposed amendment has been submitted in writing and read at the previous meeting

- 1. Registration, lodging, meals, and mileage @Federal Mileage rate. Sharing of rides and rooms is encouraged whenever possible.
- 2. Membership limited to 29 active members (amended November 2007)
- 3. In the event of illness or injury to a member (hospitalized or homebound), a card will be sent.
- 4. In the event of death of a member, a \$40 donation will be made to purchase a small tree to be planted in the neighborhood or at the member's church in memory of the deceased.
- 5. Our club will not give gifts to our club members that present programs to our club.
